

Minister to Senior Adults

Primary Function/General Purpose of Position

Under the supervision of the Senior Minister and in cooperation with staff, lay leadership, and church committees, the Minister of Senior Adults is responsible for ministering to and with senior adults, carrying out the senior adult ministry of the church, and addressing the unique spiritual needs and concerns of senior adults.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Primary responsibilities are to be focused on the spiritual development, pastoral care, and wellness of the seniors (65 years+) in the church.
- Oversee/lead faith formation events, fellowship gatherings, and spiritual formation of senior adults.
- Provide educational resources, workshops, and other events on topics relevant to senior adults' spiritual and practical needs.
- In coordination with the Senior Adult Committee (Standing Committee), plan trips, special events, and mission opportunities for senior adults.
- Participate in the cultivation of (senior adult) prospective church members.
- In coordination with the Senior Adult Lunch and More Committee (Ad Hoc Committee), assist in planning monthly programs.
- Shares responsibility with Minister of Community Engagement regarding Neighborhood Partnership.
- In coordination with the Minister of Pastoral Care and the Pastoral Care Ministries Committee, provide pastoral care to senior adults facing life transitions, health challenges, or loss.
- Assists in preparing the senior adult ministry budget.
- Participate in worship leadership and pastoral care ministry as needed and available.
- Perform other duties as assigned in collaboration with supervisor.
